NON-ELDERLY ADULTS

"Adults" as used in this fact sheet refers to non-elderly adults 18 - 64 years of age.

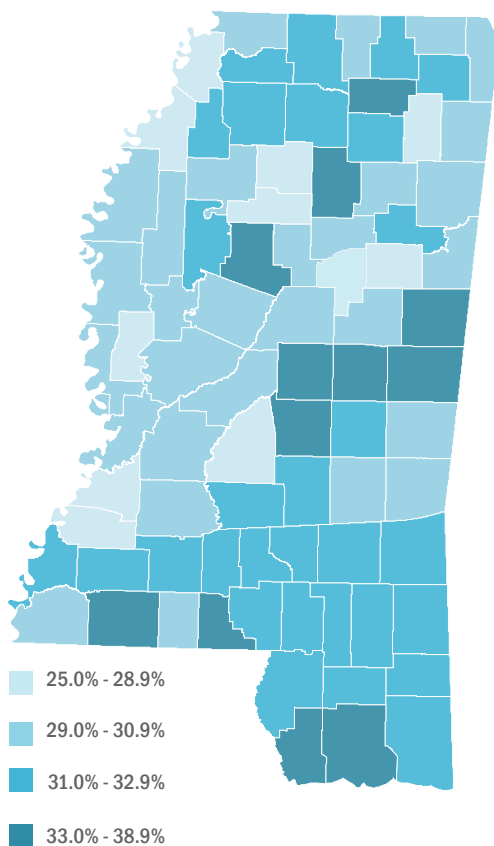
This fact sheet presents the percentage and number of non-elderly uninsured adults at the county level in Mississippi, highlighting groups who may be eligible for premium subsidies through the Health Insurance Marketplace or coverage through the expansion of Medicaid authorized under the Affordable Care Act (ACA). The ACA provides for premium tax credits for persons with household incomes between 100 percent and 400 percent of the federal poverty level (FPL) and gives states the option to expand Medicaid to persons with household incomes up to 138 percent FPL. All data are from the 2013 Small Area Health Insurance Estimates (SAHIE), United States Census Bureau.

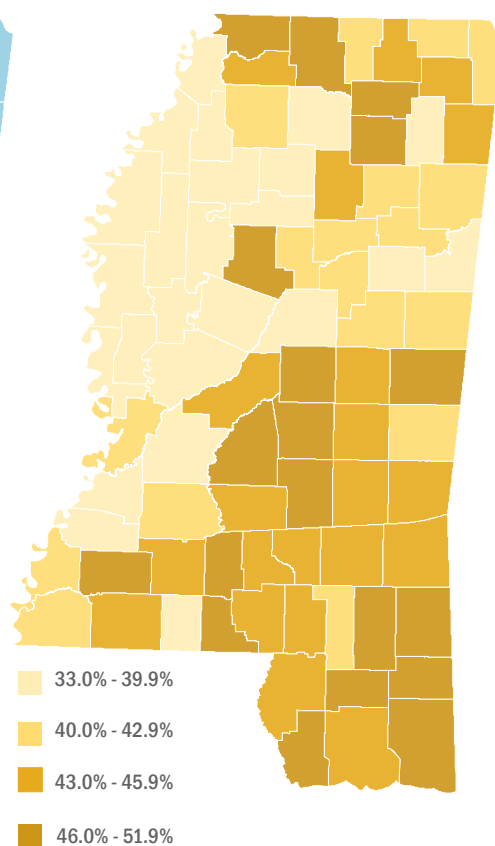

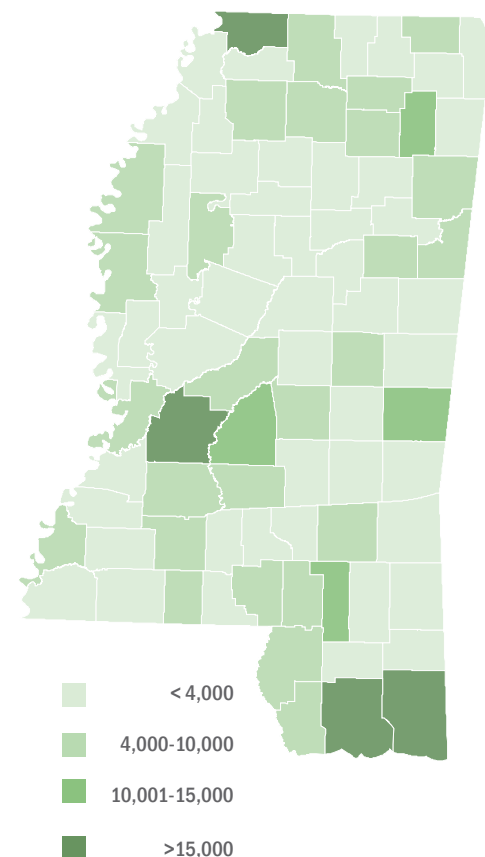

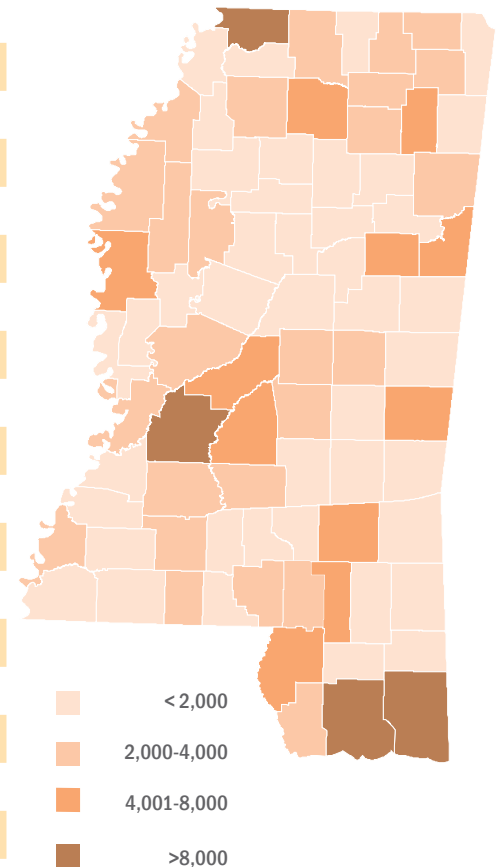

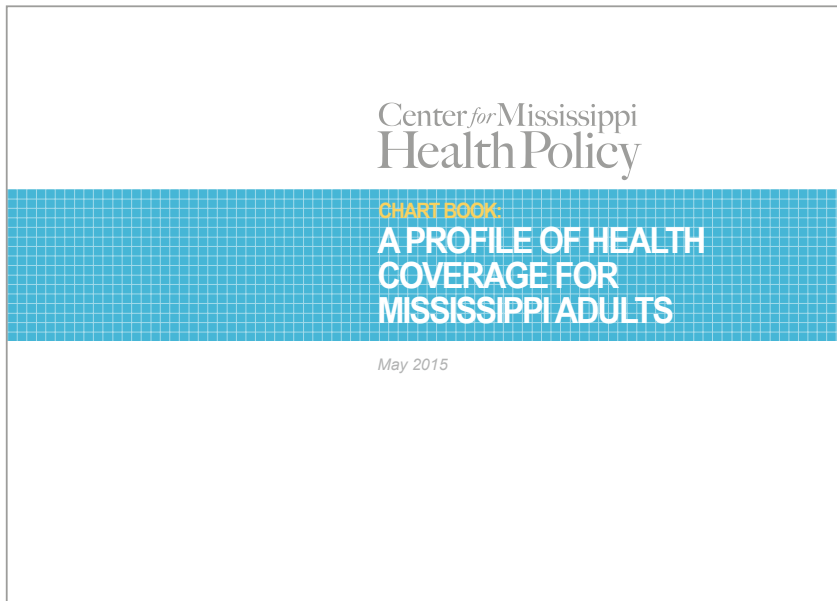
